

# BROWARD COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

## Summer 2020 Co-Enrolled Program

### OPTION 1 – (Open to all students Grades 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>)

Students who are enrolled in co-enrolled courses via the Community Schools or Adult Center may continue until Tuesday, August 11, 2020. High school counselors or designee may continue to enroll new students in course(s) until Tuesday, July 2, 2020. The classes in option 1 are only available in the evening. Priority will be given to Seniors planning to graduate in Summer 2020.

➤ **Date and Time:**

- Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup> - Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>
- Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/ Thursday (two (2) days per week) – 4.0 hours per day – 5:00 pm – 9:00 pm

➤ **How to Register:**

- A student must be referred by their School Counselor or designee.
- Visit Broward Community Schools webpage ([www.browardcommunityschools.com](http://www.browardcommunityschools.com)) to complete a Co-Enrolled Registration form for the locations listed below.
- Click on the Co-Enrollment Referral Form Link.
- Complete the Co-Enrollment Referral Form.
- Submit Referral by clicking the “SEND” button.
- Allow up to 3 business days for processing.
- **Enter Code in TERMS** – A field has been created in TERMS on the A04 panel that will indicate a high school student has been approved to enroll in a co-enrolled class. *Placing a “Y” into the “C” field on the A04* will flag and transfer data to the Co-Enrolled registration system (FOCUS) so that we will not have to re-create the student demographics.
- Contingent on availability, the student will receive confirmation of their enrollment in a summer course.
- **Last Date to Enroll – Tuesday, July 2, 2020**
- The program is competency-based. Students who complete .5 credit before the end of the term may enroll for an additional course(s) that is listed on the registration application, however, there is no guarantee the additional course(s) can be completed in the remaining time.
- **Reminder: Athletes may not take Odysseyware courses. We have a separate option for athletes which has also been customized for acceleration.**

### OPTION 2 – (Open to all students Grades 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>)

➤ **Session Date:**

- Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup> – Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>
- Monday – Thursday (four (4) days per week) - 4 hours per day – **MORNING CLASSES**
- **Registration Start Date: May 18, 2020**
- **Last Date to Enroll: Thursday, June 25<sup>th</sup>**

➤ **How to Register:**

- A student must be referred by their School Counselor or designee.
  - Complete a Co-Enrollment Registration application by visiting one of the school's website listed below.
  - Click on and complete the Co-Enrollment Referral Form link.
  - Submit Referral by clicking the "SEND" or "SUBMIT" button.
  - Allow up to 3 business days for processing.
  - **Enter Code in TERMS** – A field has been created in TERMS on the A04 panel that will indicate a high school student has been approved to enroll in a co-enrolled class. *Placing a "Y" into the "C" field on the A04* will flag and transfer data to the Co-Enrolled registration system (FOCUS) so that we will not have to re-create the student demographics.
