School Improvement Plan – (Godoy)

Mrs. Bretz described our Professional Learning Committee.

- PLCs are data driven assessments especially intermediate
- Vertical teaching across all grades using anchor charts for support (going off of lower grades)
- Second iReady saw growth
- Star Reading and Math for primary: many had growth and those who didn't have growth we had conversations with the teacher to make a growth plan
- Using benchmark through testing and talking with accountable talk from standards.

Safety Updates – (Godoy)

- Did very well on safety inspection
