School Improvement Plan -

Mrs. Bretz discussed the standards and assessments (iReady/Fast/STAR)

- Mr. Brodsky used a Taylor Swift song when teaching elements to have buy in from students.
- She broke down how we use iReady when planning crunch materials for the students.
- FAST questions are been analyzed question by question by each student to see how they did and what we need to continue to teach to see growth.
- Students in 3-5 working on 3rd domain.
- Student right now are struggling with literature character and setting.
- K-2 students on basic skills ELA iReady went up from last year.
- Fair games standards Mrs. Orange pulls 5th grade to go over standards from 3- 4 to help with teaching.
- Crunch plan: K-2 will start in second week in April. Teachers aren't going to change their routines but instead will take out 20 minutes from science by taking sample test questions and using them to reteach standards. 3-5 using Benchmark for crunch this program annotations.

Safety Updates – (Godoy)
