School Improvement Plan –

Mrs. Goodman - Social Emotional Learning program

- She has been going into classroom to discuss different types of social issues that have been coming up. When she meets with a class, they discuss ways that these situations should be handled and feelings that may come with them.
- Zen Den which is done every Monday with fourth grade first thing before they go to class. It is a time for the whole grade to discuss issues that have come up and ways to handle them or avoid them.
- Individual group counseling where she will work with individual students of two or three that are having a problem and go over strategies and techniques to deal with it.
- She reviewed briefly the mandated lessons that classroom teachers are use in their classrooms on substance abuse and child trafficking.
- Resilience training for students. Taught in the classroom and we are lucky to have Opel here who is the one who runs the program Mon. – Thurs.
- Life skills wellness is another program where staff appoint students for leadership, talk to the students about how they make a difference with helping peers, as well as character education

Safety Updates – (Godoy)

- Not a lot to report. It is important for parent to have conversations with their children about appropriate and inappropriate ways of talking at school. Remind them to always talk to a trusted adult at school

whenever they are in a difficult situation. Also, about how they react to a situation (not using words like hit, kill).

- Single point entry at every school. It is important to show your id at the camara before you enter the building. At no time should anyone be entering at a side door of the building as the school needs to be accountable for everyone who enters.
