STAFF CREATED NEW QAC SANTIZING SOLUTION, LATER MEASURED AT 200 PPM. - CORRECTED ON SITE</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). Food shall only contact surfaces that are clean and sanitized.</p>
