

Apply For the 2019-2020 Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK)/Enrichment Program Now





VPK / ENRICHMENT PROGRAM INFORMATION

VPK is a program available to children that will be 4-years-old by September 1, 2019. We offer full day (VPK/Enrichment) and half day (VPK Only) programs from 8:00 a.m. — 2:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. All schools offer free breakfast and field trips. All teachers hold a valid Florida Teachers Certificate specializing in Early Childhood Education.



VPK / ENRICHMENT TITLE I SELECTION

These schools offer a **free**, **full school-day** of instruction available to children that live in a Title I school boundary. **See website for list of available schools.** Students are selected based upon academic need. Contact each school to learn about after school care availability.



VPK / ENRICHMENT LOTTERY SELECTION

These schools offer both full and half day opportunities. Some schools offer a free, full day program while others offer 3 hours of free instruction (VPK Only) plus 3 hours of optional fee-supported instruction. Students are selected via lottery process. **See website for list of schools.**
