For added comfort, volunteers should bring a hat, sunscreen and gloves. If a volunteer doesn't have gloves, that's okay – the PATCH has some gardening and latex gloves for volunteers to use at no cost.</p> <p>Water will be available for volunteers at the PATCH.
