Second Grade

Our Super Second Graders are excited to start 2017! We are continually working on reading comprehension and are thrilled to start our new unit covering the lifecycle of plants and animals, as well as the economy. In math, we are working on addition and subtraction with regrouping. Please encourage your child to read nightly and utilize iStation. We are looking forward to a successful 2017!

Third Grade

Teachers are providing creative strategies to improve each student's reading comprehension skills. Our third grade students have been reading nonfiction articles through Achieve 3000 which is an online reading program. They are actively working in small reading groups, utilizing our Accelerated Reader Program and reading articles through Achieve 3000. This has given students opportunities to raise their lexile levels to new heights. We are working diligently to prepare our students for the FSA in the spring.

In math, students have memorized their multiplication facts to create and solve real world problems utilizing division. We are planning to use hands-on activities to understand how to compare and contrast fractions. Parents can continue to monitor your child's mastery of skills through Think Central.

Computerized instruction, manipulative activities, and support from our wonderful parents provide a stimulating environment for learning. We are looking forward to a semester of enriched lessons.
