### **RESPONSE TO INTERVENTION (RTI)**

Response to Intervention (RtI) uses student academic and behavior information to identify students with learning and behavior needs to guarantee that those in danger of failure and/or retention are receiving assistance and support.

#### **GRADUATION/COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS (EARLY WARNING INDICATORS)**

# Describe all intervention strategies employed by the school to improve the academic performance of students identified by the early warning system.

To address the students identified by the early warning system, we will implement the following intervention strategies:

- To address students with attendance below 90%, teachers will contact parents to inquire about attendance inconsistencies and help as needed to help increase student attendance. If there is a technology problem identified, teachers will refer parents to Mr. Naami (technology specialist) for laptop replacement or troubleshooting.
- If the problem doesn't involve technology, teachers will complete a social worker or school counselor referral. The social worker or school counselor will contact the parent/student to ascertain the problem that has resulted in poor attendance and provide resources as necessary to increase attendance.
- Students with 1 or more suspensions will be referred to the school counselor by the teacher for SEL and behavior activities and small group meetings to
  address behavior concerns. In addition, teachers and staff will employ interventions from the school-wide behavior plan.
- Students who scored a level 1 in ELA or math or who have been retained will receive interventions according to their RTI plan. Teachers will complete an RTI referral for any students who have not been referred and the RTI team will develop a plan for interventions based on the student's academic needs. These interventions will be completed by the teacher. The students will be assessed based on their plan and the RTI team will decide if the students require further testing by the school psychologist.
