

Hollywood Hills Elementary



Parents/guardians, in an effort to increase safety for all students, several measures will be put into place effective Monday, January 4, 2016.

1. The front gate to the school will be kept locked until 7:20. At that point the gate will be opened to allow students onto campus to go to breakfast, the school store and/or their waiting area. Prior to 7:20, faculty and staff are not present to provide appropriate supervision.
2. Likewise, (1) the gate by the west car loop in-between the administrative building and the old cafeteria, (2) the two pedestrian gates on each side of the bus loop, and (3) the bus loop gate on the north side of the building will remain locked until 7:20.
3. Before 8:00 a.m. the only doors opened in the two-story building will be the downstairs and upstairs doors by the cafeteria. All Kindergarten, 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th grade students (not accompanied by their parents) must enter the building at 7:30 and wait outside of their classroom with their classmates. This gives your child an opportunity to begin to focus on the upcoming school day.
4. On the west side car loop, there are currently two doors open in the morning where 2nd graders and three 3rd grade classes can enter the building. Only one door will remain open in order to more closely monitor who is entering the building.
5. As a reminder, you need to stop by the front office to sign in with your ID if you are coming onto campus if you need to enter any building for any reason. This is for the safety of all students. If you are seen inside a building without a visitor's badge, you will be redirected to come to the front office.
