School Updates: Specials and Science

Specials areas are continuing as they normally would, in the brick and mortar setting. Operating on regular four day rotations. Mrs. Hofkins following NGSS (Next Generation Science Standards). Science lab is supplemental to classroom instruction.

Open Forum

When will we be returning face to face? Superintendent Runcie would like several weeks of a low infection rate in Broward. There will be a school board meeting/workshop on September 22nd, return to school plan is anticipated to be discussed at that time. What measures are being taken to ensure a safe return to HHE's campus? Campus is being thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.

Attendance is being reported by your child's homeroom teacher, taken at the start of class.

Report cards: First quarter report cards are sent home November 12. Interim reports are going home this Friday, September 11th. The first marking period ends on October 16th. Interim reports will be available via Virtual Counselor.
