- Principal's update

The first day of the third marking period is January 13th. Report cards will be issued to families on Wednesday, February 3rd. Prior to winter break, survey went out to parents inf they wanted their children to return face to face. Big response, in the December survey there was an additional 75 stuents who will be returning face to face, starting tomorrow (January 13th). Laptops and headsets are still needed. Survey mentioned there would be more traditional type classes, compared to the computer. The survey said that may be happening, not for sure happening. Here at HHE, we have a large percentage of our students Face to Face. 45% from October to January 12th, survey responses, we will have about 51 to 52% of students face to face. Some students are struggling academically or have spotty attendance, based off this attendance or struggling, district is still highly encouraging those students to come face to face. 70 struggling that are not face to face, if they come back we would have about 50% back, somewhere between 9 to 15 kids per room face to face. In order to make a class 100% face to face, we would need to make someone else online. Leading to number of 10-18. Spocial distancing guidelines would not be relaxed, I am not comfortable with relaxing them that much. Ultimately, our job is for the safety and well being of our students, staff and faculty. We will be remaining in a hybrid model of teaching where teachers will still be teaching via the computer.
