- Principal's update Mr. Fossas

5 STAR School: On Sunday, we received news that we are a 5 STAR school for the '18-19 school year. I'm very proud that we offer an inclusive environment to all of our students.

- Mid-Year Reflection Mrs. O'Sullivan

Mrs. O'Sullivan shared a PowerPoint presentation on our mid-year status of our school improvement plan.

Mr. Fossas added that this year we received additional funds from Title III to provide FSA camp experience to our ELLs.

Mr. Jones—What else are we doing in class, besides from the extra support like Mrs. Martinez and Mrs. Reed? Mr. Fossas: We have iReady, which custom tailors an educational path, in reading and math. This is for every

student—not just remediation but also for enrichment. Robotics team for 4th and 5th grade, engaging in regular curriculum, but also coding and engineering for enrichment. We have multiple datapoints, from iReady, regular chapter tests, BAS scores, BSA and see if the data is all relative/consistent.
