Call to Order: A meeting of the **Hollywood Hills Elementary School Advisory Council** was held in the School's Media Center on April 23, 2019. Co-Chair, Mrs. Anita O'Sullivan called the meeting to order at 2:20 pm. Dr. Laura Saef recorded the minutes for this meeting.

Minutes: Anita O'Sullivan motioned to approve the minutes of March 12, 2019. Motion to except and approve the minutes. The minutes were read: motion to approve by Maylin Hernandez and seconded by Shannon Powers.

Schoolwide Behavior Plan 2019-2020

Mrs. Rivera reviewed the Schoolwide Positive Behavior Plan. She explained that ALL threats must be investigated. She shared data collected at our school regarding behavior (ex. 4% 0-1 referrals, 3% 2-5 referral, 1% >5 referrals). She also

explained how the plan must to be rolled out and who must be involved in the production of the plan. She explained how the plan was developed and then voted on by the faculty. She enforced that the plan was written with positive reinforcement and not negative as it a SPBP. Rules must be very specific and displayed in specific areas around the school. The plan is introduced to the students at the very beginning of the school year. It is taught to the children and then is implemented throughout the year. The students are given points for good behavior and then are rewarded with a grade level event at the end of the quarter. Only students who earn the points participate in the SPBP event. There are very specific steps to follow for infractions such as inappropriate classroom behavior (ex. calling out, classroom, disruptions, etc.). Examples were also shared regarding behaviors warranting referrals. Mrs. Rivera shared programs being implemented such as CHAMPS (a positive behavior program) and data regarding the effectiveness of SPBP our school. She shared that the data indicated that our plan is effective. We will have a CHAMPS professional development course next year in order to train more of our teachers in this program. We are also looking into having more teachers mentor students with behavior issues. Additionally, we look closely at subgroups and recognized that we have points on which to work. For example, the African American subgroup makes up 15% of the school population, received 59% of the referrals. The Hispanic subgroup makes up 46% of population, received 19% of the referrals. White- subgroup, makes up 34% of population, yet received 21% of the referrals. Based on the data, the plan is created and implemented. The plan is revisited throughout the year. It is modified and updated as needed. Mrs. Rivera explained the tier levels and how it relates to the plan. Mrs. Rivera also explained how some of the faculty is learning more about the race disparity– relations.

Principal's Update

Mr. Fossas was not in attendance. Ms. Rivera gave a brief update on school data and Ms. Dallas will update us with an analysis of our school's data at our next meeting.
