- School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR)- behaviors that need to be addressed. We have had no incidents that needed to be reported to SESIR.
- School Data- this year we were rated a B. Our lowest 25th percentile did not do as well as anticipated, we are not an A school. This year

we have a new testing system, the FAST- (Florida Assessment of Student Thinking). We will not be graded on gains, just proficiency. The test is broken into 3 times.

• Schoolwide Behavior Plan: Mrs. Rivera We start in February, end in May. We must plan, share, and vote. Lesson plans were created to share at the beginning of the school year. We have a site, Navigate 360, with lessons for behaviors. There is a student discipline flow chart. We have positive behavior preventions and supports. It can be found on the Broward webpage. We have a point system plan on a monthly basis by grade level, appropriate to their age. Every grade level is choosing points for within classroom (monthly) and then earn an incentive. Starting in September the students will earn points in classrooms, monitored by their teachers. This is submitted as part of SIP Plan.

 Benchmark Advance data.
 We are testing using STAR.
 We have new reading and
 math series, Benchmark
 Advance for reading and
 Envision for math.
- Specials- Dr. Saef Science standards are the same. 5th graders take the science FSA in May which addresses standards K-5.
