VII. Department's Report

- a. Math & ELA
 - i. iReady Diagnostics to see that students are making typical growth (half a year) coming up next week. Teachers are holding data chats with students to let them know where they stand.
- b. Science (6th-8th grade)
 - i. Biology HS will be having their midterm given during the last week Dec. 13-17. Reminder this is 30% of their semester grade.
 - ii. 8th grade physical science is finishing up- Matter and properties and changes and will be taking a CFA during the week of Dec. 13-17 as well.
 - iii. 7th grade classes are currently on cells and infectious agents and will be taking their CFA test during the week of Dec 13-17.
 - iv. 6th grade classes are currently working on plate tectonics and weather and climate.
- c. Social Studies
 - i. 6-8th grade will be exploring career goals and different ways of learning on Naviance. Naviance is a program on their clever that they will use throughout high school. It is a career ready and

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college program. Students will start exploring different options now and return to different activities throughout the year.

- ii. 8th grade social studies will be starting the Revolutionary War period. Student will learn about British policies, the Declaration of Independence, and the Revolutionary War. This unit will be started this week and the CFA will be given in January.
 - iii. 7th grade In unit 3, students will be learning about state and local governments, the trial process, and sources of law. The next CFA will be December 13th and 14th.
 - iv. 6th Grade is finishing up Ancient Egypt and will also have a CFA December 13th and 14th.
 - v. Students can use USA Test Prep to study for the CFA along with their notes and Canvas assignments.
