Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the new school year at Griffin Elementary School! Band is offered to **Fourth and Fifth** grade students. **Band begins on Thursday**, **September 19, 2024.** Band will meet after school on Thursdays, and Fridays from 2 PM to 3 PM in the music room. Band is offered from the months of October to May. Students will need to wear black pants and a new band t-shirt shirt for our band concert attire. Our band t-shirts will be \$12.00. Band has two concerts a year. Our first concert will be on January 15th at 6:00pm on our Griffin stage.

Band students will need to rent or purchase an instrument to participate in band. Instruments can be rented at area band stores (please see the the attached list of local band stores with their addresses and phone numbers). Instruments can also be purchased online. Instruments in our band are flute, Bb clarinet, alto saxophone, Bb trumpet, and a snare drum kit (drums).

Band students will need to leave their band instruments with them in their classrooms while they are in school. Students cannot leave their instruments over night on school property. Griffin aftercare students will need to report to their aftercare area for attendance **before** coming to band. This year, band students will need to purchase one book: The Standard of Excellence Band Book One, which has a red cover.

Band students will need the following:

Flute: flute, cleaning rod, "The Standard of Excellence Band Book One," for Flute with interactive practice cd.

Bb Clarinet: Bb clarinet, clarinet swab, **a box** of size two reeds (beginner clarinets use a lot of reeds), cork-grease, "The Standard of Excellence Band Book One," for clarinet with interactive practice cd.

<u>Alto Saxophone:</u> alto saxophone, saxophone swab, **one box** of size two reeds, cork grease, and "The Standard of Excellence Band Book One," for saxophone with interactive practice cd.

Bb Trumpet: Bb trumpet, valve oil, "The Standard of Excellence Band Book One," for Bb trumpet with interactive practice cd.

Percussion: Percussion/Drums:

Snare Drum kit or drum set, drum sticks size 2B, "The Standard of Excellence Book One" and a rubber practice pad to mute the snare drum sound.

BAND CLUB EXPECTATIONS

- 1. **Common Goals-** The common goal of the band is to prepare students for middle school band through teamwork and self-discipline for a lifetime of enjoyment.
- 2. **Team work-** Each student must understand that he/she is an important part of the band group and without cooperation and support from the entire group, the group as a whole is not as strong.
- 3. **Self Discipline-**Each student must understand that he/she is responsible for his/her own behavior. The classroom rules and consequences are the same in after school band as they are in the classroom.
- 4. Students are responsible for practicing their instrument at home every day.
- 5. Each student must be aware of the goals of the band.
- 6. A student's classroom teacher has the authority to remove a student from band because of poor classroom behavior or failing grades in any academic area.

Band Rules:

I will do my best.

I will enter and leave the room quietly.

I will listen and follow directions.

I will respect others.

I will raise my hand to speak.

Band Consequences:

Band students can move up or down the school wide behavior plan. Students who achieve outstanding will earn a treat at the end of each band class.

Band is a privilege and good behavior is a **must**.

Students who misbehave consistently will be permanently removed from band.

Band Attendance:

Attendance will be taken at **each** band rehearsal. Students who miss many (3-5) rehearsals with no letter of excuse will not be permitted to perform in our concerts. If a student is absent due to illness, family emergency, or doctor's appointment, it can be excused with a written note.

Band Tardies:

Being on time to band is very important. Band class begins at 2pm. Students who are repeatedly late to band (3 or more times) will not be allowed to participate in band. If a student is late to band because they are at a safety patrol post, please let me know. They will be excused.

Anti Bullying Policy:

The anti-bullying policy in our school applies to after school band. Bullying will not be tolerated.

Band Incentives:

Band students will have an opportunity to earn 1 sticker for each completed in class worksheet. Students can earn 25 stickers for participating in an evening band concert. Students will earn a music prize after 50 stickers, (music pencils, erasers, etc) and 75 stickers. Students who earn 100 stickers or more will earn a band pin at the end of the school year. Students who earn an X on the chart for unacceptable behavior will not earn their band Students who quit band or are removed from band will not receive these incentive awards.

<u>Cell Phones:</u> Students are not allowed to use their cell phones in band class or at dismissal.
