



# Broward County Library (BCL) Digital Direct Card

The BCL Digital Direct Card is a virtual card which allows students 24/7 access to the Broward County Library (BCL) digital academic resources through their partnership with Broward County Schools.

What's the advantage? Students can log into to the Broward County Library Resources using their school ID. (The username is the Student ID number; the password is the last four digits of their student number).



Parents have the option to **OPT-IN** to the program for their student which is available in the Student Code of Conduct electronic booklet at the beginning of the school year. **Students that opted in previously do not need to opt-in again.**

Students and Parents will have another opportunity to be a part of this great partnership with the Broward County Library at the start of the upcoming school year 2019-2020 through the Student Code of Conduct by choosing to opt-in to the Digital Direct program.
