During our Employee Planning day in November, our staff participated in another session of our Leader in Me training. We gained even more ideas and strategies to bring to the classroom and school to help our students become leaders of their learning. Our November Habit of the Month was Putting First Things First. Some key points the children and staff learned about this habit were to:

- * Focus on the highest priorities
- * Eliminate the unimportant
- * Plan every week
- * Stay true in the moment of choice

For the months of December and January we will be focusing on Habit 4: Think Win-Win. Think Win-Win is the belief that everyone can win. It's not me or you—it is both of us. It is a belief that there are enough good things for everyone; it is an abundant way of thinking. Think Win-Win is being happy for others when good things happen to them. An idea you can do with your child(ren) at home is to play a game that has a definite winner. Explain how competition is okay when you play a game, but it is not okay in relationships. Discuss how tense it would be in your home if every situation had to have a winner. A better way to think is win-win. This means we think of solutions that we can all feel good about when there is a problem.

As the winter holidays approach we have a lot happening at Fox Trail during the month of December. Interim reports go home on December 1st. We have our Hour of Code Week happening during the week of December 5th. Students will be practicing their coding skills in every classroom! Have them show you the website at home and teach you how to code. We will also be celebrating Inclusive Schools Week, which is an annual international event celebrated the first week in December. It's a time designated to acknowledge the hard work and commitment of teachers, administrators, students, and parents in making their schools more inclusive, thereby, significantly contributing to the development of a more inclusive society. 
