In an emergency, call 911 immediately. To submit a safety or security concern that is not an emergency, please use one of the tip reporting methods provided below. Please remember you can choose to remain anonymous.

- Anonymous Tip Submission Box**
Submit a tip easily via our Anonymous Tip Submission Box (see download required). Provide as much detail as you can, including names of people involved, physical descriptions, school name, social media handles, etc.
- Call Us Anytime (Even on Holidays)**
Call our District Security Operations Center (DSOC) 24 hours a day, 7 days a week (including holidays). One of our friendly DSOC specialists will take your tip over the phone and submit it immediately to our investigators. Please let the DSOC Specialist know if you wish to remain anonymous.

ALYSSA'S ALERT

Mobile Duress Alert App

Alyssa's Alert is a mobile duress alert application that empowers staff members to immediately notify first responders in the event of an emergency. Receive potentially life-saving aid with the push of a button.

Get Help Instantly
Upon activation*, local first responders & District personnel receive an immediate notification of the emergency.

Easy to Use
Select one of the three buttons (shown right) to activate Alyssa's Alert. Assistance will immediately be dispatched to your location.**

Stay Connected
Administrators will be able to push important updates regarding an emergency situation to anyone who has downloaded Alyssa's Alert.

*Duress buttons can only be activated while physically on school property.
**Only if first responders may access location information upon button activation. Under no other circumstances is location information accessible.

Students have been doing an AMAZING job wearing their IDs every day and ensuring that they are visible. A special shoutout to our security team & teachers who ensure that all students have a current ID badge on at all times.

A few safety tips and reminders:

- All students, staff, and visitors must wear an ID badge at all times while on campus. Visitors must check in at the front office and check out upon their departure.
- Exterior gates will be locked and/or supervised at all times.
- Student drop off is in the parent loop off of Rock Island Road and remains open until 8:00 am.
- There are no food deliveries for students (i.e. Uber Eats, DoorDash, etc.)
- No student sign outs after **2:10 pm** daily. Anyone picking up a student must have parental permission and be of legal age.


