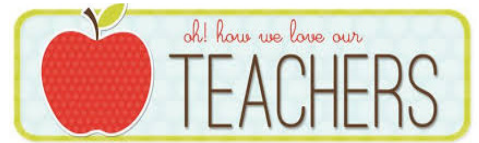

As your child moves through the grades, there are many ways to track behavior. In the primary grades, students come home talking about what color they were on for the day. As they move up through the grades, you may hear about Class Dojo or other online programs. By fourth and fifth grade, you will be hearing about mykidsbank.org and the classroom economy system.

In these upper grades, students start to learn about real world finances as they try to manage their virtual money. Each week, they receive a paycheck into their mock online bank. They can earn bonus money for a variety of reasons, like Accelerated Reader and great behavior in all different areas of school. At the same time, poor choices will cause fines, which means money will be taken out of their virtual account. At the end of each month, students need enough money in their account to pay "rent".

So what happens when fourth and fifth graders make great choices throughout the month and have money left over after "rent"? Teachers create incredible monthly reward days for the students who have earned it. These rewards range from a huge lunch bunch with friends from other classes to movies in the classroom to lunch at a fast food restaurant. What a great way to teach responsibility with a long term real-world application!
