#### **Music**

#### **Pre-Kindergarten**

In March we will continue to enjoy silly rhymes by exploring books by Dr. Seuss in honor of his birthday. Try rhyming games in the car. Give your child a simple animal name like "pig," "dog," or "cat." See if you can think of a silly phrase that completes the rhyme. For example, the cat hid under the mat. Read books, signs, menus, grocery lists. Let's get our preschoolers excited about print. Can you encourage your child to make a sign for their room? (No leprechauns allowed!) Be creative. In Spring, we look forward to exploring more about nature and colors. Thank you for partnering with us to make sure your child gets a great foundation for learning.

#### **First Grade**

First grade is excited for spring! In Math, we will be learning about two-digit addition and subtraction. Please continue to practice addition and subtraction facts with your child. In Science, we are learning about fast and slow changes to the earth and will follow it up with our unit on the sun. In ELA, the students are learning proper nouns,

forming simple sentences, and opinion writing. We are learning about fables and that stories can teach a lesson. Remember to check your child's folder and homework agenda every day for updates!
