Meet our new Assistant Principal!







iReady Diagnostic

The Diagnostic Assessment has begun. Your child should be scheduled to complete the Diagnostic in a small group setting this week or next week. Your child's teacher will communicate the schedule to you.

The Diagnostic must be completely done by the student only, otherwise your child might end up with assignments that are too hard or too easy. iReady is a research-based program that has yielded great growth for children when used 30-45 minutes per week (each subject).
