Enrollment & Class Size and Student Placement

Our enrollment is currently higher than projected. As a result, some class sizes are higher than targets. Accordingly, additional teachers will be hired and new classes will be created.

Due to the State Class Size Reduction law, students may need to be moved between teachers or to new teachers **after the start of school** to ensure compliance with the required student limits. These limits are 18 students for Kindergarten to Grade 3; 22 students for grades 4 and 5. Please know that students' needs will continue to be met through proper instruction and services.
