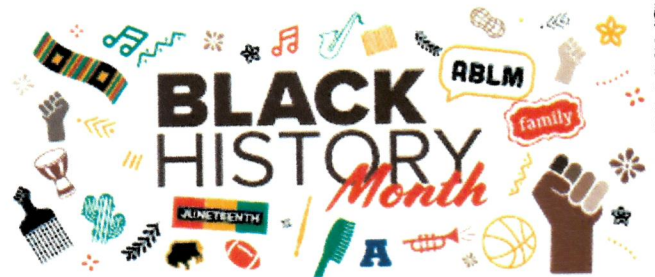

FEBRUARY CHARACTER TRAIT: HONESTY

During the month of February, NBF students will be discussing the character trait of honesty. An honest person is truthful, sincere, and fair. An honest person will also possess the character traits of good judgement, courage and responsibility.

If you'd like to encourage honesty at home, it is important to model it. Take time to explain the meaning of honesty. Share your own experiences with your children. Let them know that you aren't perfect, but explain a time when it was difficult for you to tell the truth and how honesty helped you. Remind your child that there are consequences of dishonesty, such as losing the trust and respect of others, and often times it will result in embarrassment and punishment.
