- F. School Transformation Office- Purpose and Strategies -Ms. Veda Hudge 20 schools North –3 schools The goal is to stabilize the schools. All of the schools in the transformation office have gone up. Working with the leaders to build a culture and network. Strategies to help the students succeed and how to keep those on target to keep improving. They do walk throughs in the schools and provide on the spot feedback. They are also working with FAU on programs to help students succeed. Varsity Tutoring – tutor comes into the classroom and the teacher provides the content that should be covered.
- G. District Attendance Office- Brief Summary of North Region Data, BTIP, Attendance Incentives District Coordinator of Attendance – SIP Plan – 4 goals for attendance. They would like to develop a public facing dashboard for the daily attendance rate. Poor attendance is symptom of a problem.

- **H.** Policy 4900 Policy 4900 Audio and Visual Recording of Self-Contained ESE Classrooms -PreK-12 Cameras in Classrooms Cameras will be able to bring equity for students who are non-verbal.
