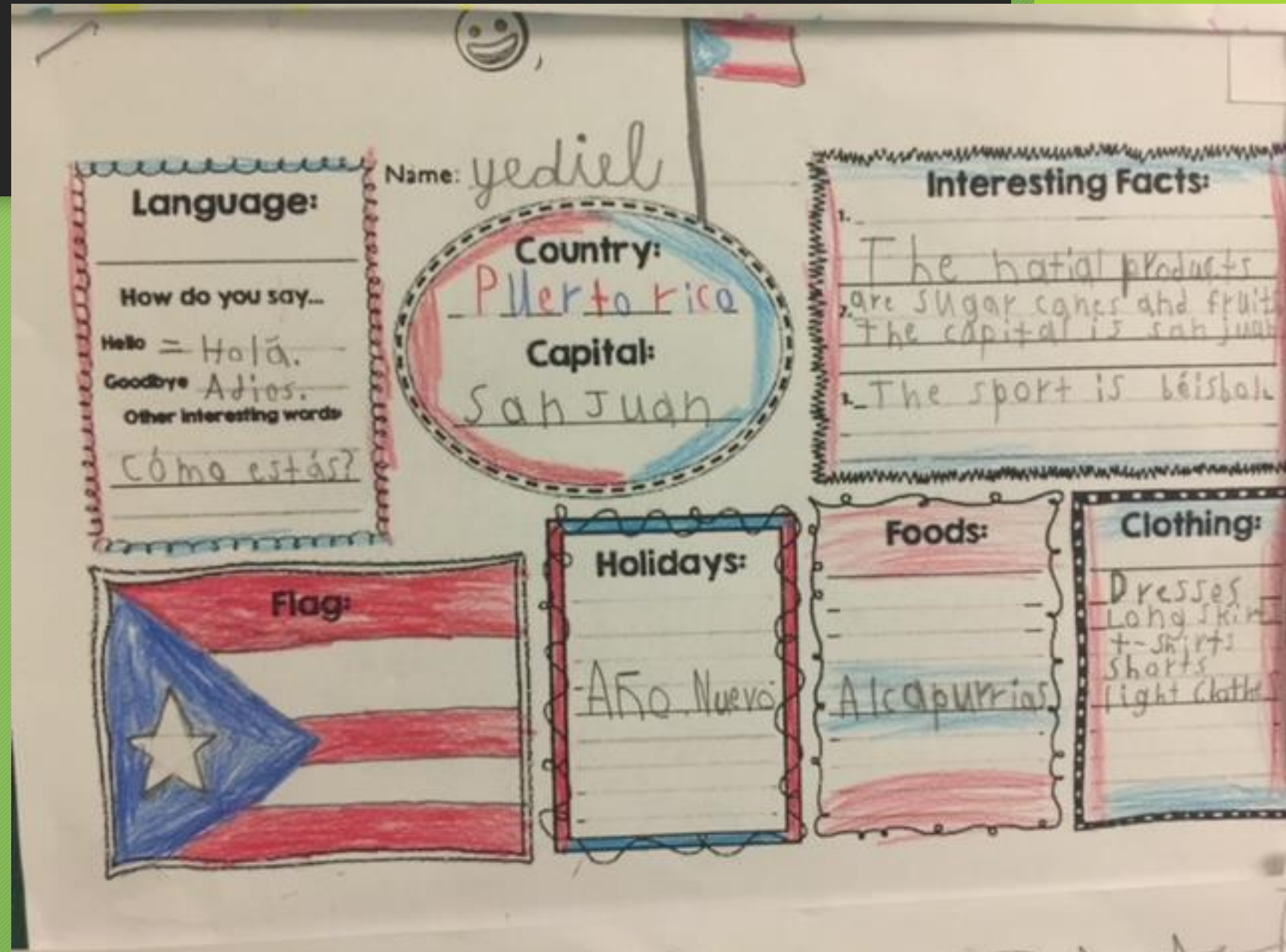

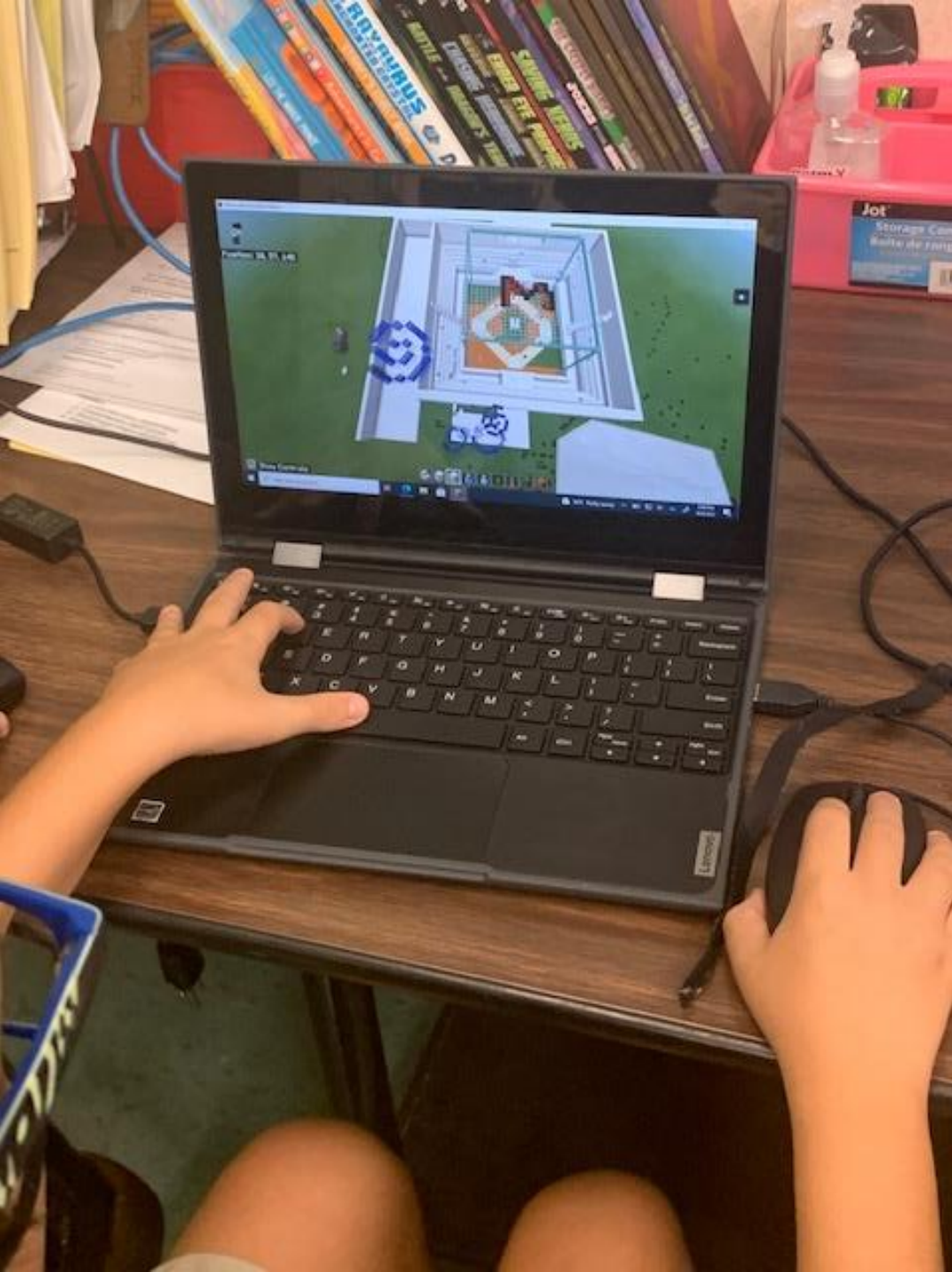
Spanish: Hispanic Heritage projects
