	(spent longer than 15 minutes within 6 feet of
	someone who was sick with a fever and cough
	or confirmed/suspected of having COVID-19?)
	Am I feeling otherwise sick or ill today?
	Am I awaiting test results for COVID-19?
	Have I tested positive for COVID-19?
	Have I been told to self-quarantine or self-
	isolate by a doctor or District administrator?

	home to get comfortable with wearing masks

Uniforms  Arrival Expectations – Bus Riders	<ul> <li>If students have uniforms, they can wear them.</li> <li>If they do not have uniforms at this time, they can come to school in dress appropriate with the Code of Conduct through January 8<sup>th</sup>.</li> <li>Ensure students arrive at bus stop at least 10 minutes before time on bus card</li> <li>Students must always wear masks while on the school bus</li> </ul>
Arrival Expectations – Car Riders	<ul> <li>All students will be checked-in by a NEE staff member to ensure they are recorded as having selected eLearning on campus</li> <li>No students should be let out of their car until checked-in by a NEE staff member</li> <li>All students must have on masks before exiting the car</li> <li>No parents will be allowed to escort students to class</li> <li>Ensure students arrive by 9:20am if a car rider</li> <li>Car Rider students will not be served breakfast if the arrive after 9:20am</li> </ul>
Office Procedures	<ul> <li>Parents needing assistance from the office must call the office from the parking lot and ask for further directions</li> <li>No parents should walk into the front office</li> <li>We will not accept "forgotten" items at this time. Students must come prepared with all materials needed for the day</li> <li>The office can be reached at 754-323-6650</li> </ul>
Early Sign-Outs for Students  Changes to Student Dismissal	<ul> <li>Reserve early student sign-outs for true emergencies only due to limited staff &amp; social distancing requirements</li> <li>Early sign-out may take 15-20 minutes from the time the parent arrives to school to sign-out the student</li> <li>Call the office from your car for directions about early sign-outs</li> <li>Any changes to a student's dismissal MUST be emailed to the teacher by 9:00am.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Parents must receive a reply confirmation from the teacher by 10:00am indicating the teacher received the email.</li> <li>If the parent does not receive a reply from the teacher by 10:00am, the parent must call the Office at 754-323-6650 for assistance.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>3" &amp; 4" grade car riders will be picked up</li> </ul>
	from the Davie Rd. car loop
	<ul> <li>All students must be picked up by 3:30pm</li> </ul>
	On Early Release days students must be
	picked up by 1:30pm
