<p>Violation #22. Cold holding temperatures Cold TCS food (milk) tested 46 to 48 F, not held at 41F or less. Cool food to 41F or below. Cold food must be held at 41F or below. Cold holding equipment was kept open during breakfast, ice placed on top of food to bring temperature down.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). PHF/TCS foods, which are held cold, and not subject to an approved HACCP plan, must be maintained at 41°F.</p>
<p>Violation #33. Proper cooling methods; adequate equipment Refrigerated equipment (milk box) not working properly, ambient air temperature is 51 F. Ambient air temperature of 41F or less required. Repair/Replace refrigerated equipment. Milk box was kept open during breakfast. Ice was placed above food to bring temperature down. Ambient air temperature taken by the end of inspection and equipment ambient air temperature tested 46 F. Keep equipment closed in between serving time to avoid losing temperature.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(2). Proper methods shall be used for cooling in accordance with Rule requirements. There should be enough equipment to meet the demand of the food operation.</p>
<p>Violation #54. Garbage & refuse disposal Dumpster drain plug missing, wastewater draining out of dumpster. Replace drain plug</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Garbage shall be disposed of to prevent vector harborage. Trash cans will be durable, cleanable, leak proof, insect and rodent resistant, and non-absorbent. Outside storage area shall be of a smooth, non-absorbent material and sloped to a drain.</p>
