



## Renovations to modular classrooms expected to begin promptly upon their delivery this week

Two Parkland elementary schools, Heron Heights and Park Trails, are now home to additional modular classrooms. With the modular units arriving on the two campuses this week, their transformation and modernization can begin promptly.

The modular classrooms will undergo improvements and beautification between now and the start of the 2017-2018 school year. The scheduled work includes roof replacement, new sections of flooring and light fixtures, exterior and interior painting, new exterior doors and door closers, and adding new toilets and mirrors in the modular classrooms' bathrooms.

By the time students return to school this fall, the modular classrooms will look and feel modernized.

Restoration to the modular classrooms started at Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Montessori, however due to site limitations much of the planned improvements could not take place there, and will be done once they arrive at the new sites. Performing the renovation work onsite at the two schools is a sensible and practical step in the overall upgrade of the modular classrooms. Carrying out the renovations work before relocating the units may have subjected the units to potential damage and unnecessary repairs after delivery to the schools. We look forward to beginning the transformation process promptly and remain confident the finished product will make for a functional and appealing addition that students at both Heron Heights and Park Trails elementary schools can enjoy.
