Safety & Security

The following procedures are expected to be followed by ALL students, staff, parents and visitors while on our campus:

BUILDING SECURITY:

- Exterior doors and classroom doors are locked at all times.
 - Campus gates are secured and/or monitored.
- Security Staff (SRO & 2 Campus monitors) conduct comprehensive sweeps of the campus each day, throughout the day.
 - Students, staff, and visitors must wear the school-issued badge at all times.
 - Students and staff are trained to follow the District Standard Response Protocols.

VISITORS:

- State Law and District Policy require schools to have very strict rules for adults to visit school.
 - Visitor parking is available in the front lot off Johnson Street.
- All visitors to campus must present photo ID and be entered in the Visitor Management System.

STUDENTS:

- Students are supervised by a staff member at all times.
- Emergency/evacuation/lockdown drills are conducted monthly.
- Quarterly Positive Behavior assemblies are held to review rules and expectations for student safety, including Anti-Bullying, and programs such as Help is Here & See Something, Say Something.

Registration Requirements

Registration for all Broward County Schools begins May 1st.

Information and documents needed to register for the upcoming school year are on our website. Please call school to schedule an appointment to register.

All Kindergarten students must be registered, even if they already attend Pre-K in Broward.

Mandatory School Unified Dress Policy Students are to wear uniforms daily as noted below:

UPPER SCHOOL (Grades 3-5)

LOWER SCHOOL (Grades K-2)

PANTHER CUBS (PreK ESE & VPK)

Navy top (t-shirt or collared) Navy Elastic Bottoms (no leggings) Navy Blue Jacket (no hoodies unless they have zipper)

Ponchos or rain jackets are recommended to be kept in bookbags (umbrellas not permitted)

FRIDAY SPIRIT DAYS:

Spirit or class t-shirt with jeans (no ripped jeans)
