

Please refrain from talking on cell phones in the drop off/pickup driveways.






SCHOOL PARTIES



Student birthday parties cannot take place during instructional time. Parents wishing to celebrate their child's birthday must notify the student's teacher in advance if they would like to bring treats to share with the class during scheduled lunch times. (All foods delivered to the school must have been prepared in a commercially licensed kitchen. Sorry, nothing homemade. Only cupcakes are permitted, as the cutting of cakes is difficult during the school day). Food/treats are not permitted to be consumed in the classroom unless prior approval is requested from administration. (Balloons are not permitted in the classroom.)



Any student who arrives at school after the second bell rings at 8:00 a.m. will be required to have his/her parent come into the office to sign him/her into school as tardy. Students arriving after 10:00 a.m. are required to have a doctor's note for admittance. Habitual tardies will be addressed by administration.
