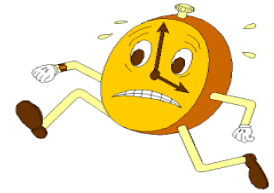

TARDIES

SCHOOL SAFETY
PARENTS, PLEASE NOTE THAT THERE IS NO supervision BEFORE 7:15 A.M.

All students arriving early to school before 7:30 a.m. must report directly to the cafeteria. Breakfast is served from 7:15 a.m. until 7:50 a.m. Students arriving after 7:50 a.m. will not be admitted to the cafeteria. Students who arrive on a late school bus will be allowed to eat breakfast.

SCHOOL PARTIES



Student birthday parties cannot take place during instructional time. Parents wishing to celebrate their child's birthday must notify the student's teacher in advance if they would like to bring treats to share with the class during scheduled lunch times. (All foods delivered to the school must have been prepared in a commercially licensed kitchen. Sorry, nothing homemade. Only cupcakes are permitted, as the cutting of cakes is difficult during the school day). Food/treats are not permitted to be consumed in the classroom unless prior approval is requested from administration. (Balloons are not permitted in the classroom.)
