Tips Just for Spelling Tests

In most schools, a weekly spelling test is a fact of life. Here are some ways to take the drudgery out of studying spelling words:

- 1. Focus on test improvements rather than test scores. Each time your child gets more words correct, that's a time to celebrate.
- 2. Use all senses. Don't just spell words out loud. Write words in the air or on a special chalk board, Make up silly songs or raps.
- 3. Study in small spurts. Spell a word at each red light...or before dessert...or in the bathtub...or while doing dishes together.
