Where do students driving to school park?

Any student driving to school is permitted to park in the Senior Lot located off Holmberg Road. Students should park on the west side of the parking lot closest to the football field.

Where can students get dropped off?

Students getting dropped off to school should be dropped off in the main parking lot in front of the school.

Where do students enter campus?

All students enter campus through the main red gates in the front of the school.

Once I enter campus where do I go?

Attendance will be taken after you enter campus. Look for the tables set up by alphabetical order to check in. After attendance is taken proceed to the location of your service project for your project introduction: Feeding the First Responders Breakfast (Cafeteria), Marjory's Garden (Marjory's Garden – located at the SW back of the school), Campus Beautification (Main Courtyard), Spending a Mindful Morning with the MSD Mind Body Club (Media Center). Service projects are located outside so please monitor the weather and plan accordingly.

What do students need to bring?

All students must bring their MSD ID, bottle of water, and gloves(latex or gardening) if possible.

Are backpacks or bags allowed on campus?
