Call to Order:

Minutes:

• WELCOME AND OPENING OF MEETING

- The SAC Committee members were welcomed, and Ms. Jones reiterated the meeting's purpose.

• SIP MONITORING- LSW PLAN

○ LIFE SKILLS AND WELLNESS INITIATIVE:

- Ms. Jones emphasized that the Life Skills and Wellness (LSW) initiative at Walker Elementary aims to educate parents on fostering self-awareness, resilience, and relationship skills in students.
- She highlighted that life skills help children navigate challenges, manage emotions, and build positive relationships, while wellness encompasses emotional well-being, supportive relationships, and overall personal growth. Developing strong life skills enhances academic performance and equips students with the tools needed for lifelong success.

○ GOALS FOR THE YEAR:

- Self-Awareness: Help students understand and manage their emotions.
- Resilience: Teach students to recover from setbacks and persist through challenges.
- Relationship Skills: Foster positive peer interactions and strong teacher-student connections

○ LSW DATA:

- Life Skills Awareness Assessments show that many students are still developing these skills, with low or average levels in self-awareness, resilience, and relationship skills.
- **The school is supporting students by:**
 - Providing weekly resiliency lessons.
 - Partnering with organizations such as Prevention Central and district support services.
 - Offering family counseling resources.
 - Utilizing the Foster Grandparent Program in primary grades.
 - Implementing the 5000 Role Models program.

- Hosting family engagement sessions to strengthen the connection between home and school efforts.
- **Parent support at home:**
- Self-Awareness- Encourage your child to name their feelings when they are upset or happy. Use phrases like, "How do you feel about that?" or "What do you need right now?"
- Resilience- Help your child see mistakes as learning opportunities. Share examples of times you've overcome challenges to model perseverance. •
- Relationship Skills- Encourage teamwork and communication during family activities like games or chores. Teach them how to listen actively by modeling it during conversations.
