## **Parent Reminders**

- Car loop reminders: It's important that parents do not use cell phones in the car loop for the safety of our students and staff. Finally, please ensure that you are picking up and dropping off your child in a timely manner. For your child's safety, students should not be dropped off at the school prior to 7:30 a.m. and should not be picked up later than 2:30 p.m. Supervision is not provided outside of these time frames.


