

Financial Assistance for Cancer Patients by Florida Cancer Foundation Inc.

Florida Cancer Foundation Inc. helps individuals with their essential living expenses while they undergo treatment for cancer. The foundation pays for non-medical bills such as overdue rent, mortgage payments, electricity, and water.

Services include:

- Rent or mortgage payments
- Utility payments (water, sewer, electric)
- Telephone payments (landline or mobile)
- Auto payment and/or auto insurance

For one to qualify they must be actively undergoing cancer treatment, be a Florida resident, have an annual household income at or below 200% of the national poverty guidelines and complete and submit an application for assistance and all required support documentation.

Services this program provides: help pay for housing help pay for utilities help pay for internet or phone financial assistance
