 - iii. Mrs. Butler will be conducting a workshop on Thursday, May 5, during 3rd and 4th period for seniors that are scheduled to test on May 7. She has also been conducting tutorials on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

 - ii. The FSA Reading Test will be replaced by 3 progress monitoring tests; however, current 10th, 11th, and 12th graders are still required to take the FSA Reading Test to satisfy the reading requirement, so retakes will continue next year
 - iii. The Algebra EOC, as well as the other EOC's will remain. The Algebra EOC is still a requirement for students to receive their diploma.
