

Sunset Lakes Elementary School SAC Meeting 2/19/2020

- 1. <u>Call to order</u>: Meeting started at 5:39 pm.
- 2. Welcome and approval of minutes:
 - a. MS VanDusen welcomed everyone. Anyone guests who would like to be added as an official member should please see her after the meeting.
 - b. Minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve by Ms. Moas and second Ms. Alberti.
- 3. <u>School Improvement Plan Monitor Academic Programs</u>.
 - a. Ms. Soto explained the various academic programs that SLE is using currently and that it might need for next year.
 - b. \$3,037.13 is left in Accountability Funds Account that SAC approves for allocation. There are two options being considered:
 - i. Coach Digital—2nd-5th grade reading program. This is a digital platform with Triumph Learning books from levels K-8. Utilized for standards' based instruction and can be used also for remediation and enrichment. \$6499 is the cost of the digital platform.
 - 1. For remediation, this is very important. "Ladders to Success" books that match the standards.
 - ii. LLI Program—not on campus currently. SLE has 1 set that Ms. R. Gonzalez got through a grant. This program aligns through the BAS program to scaffold to the next level. For struggling readers, this is used frequently. It has the questions built in to the reading so that students are exposed to the format for the BAS before the testing. This purchase is for the hard copy books. They are not grade level specific, but are color coded based on level of reading. A set is used across multiple grades. Other schools have 2 boxes—one that is A-J and one that is for the other levels and the teachers share. Each box is about \$2000.
 - iii. Our current textbooks owned by the school are a little old. New books will be purchased by County in the next few years that align to the new standards.
 - iv. Motion to Approve Coach Digital by Johanna Moas and seconded by Mr. Figueroa.

4. Construction Update:

- a. Building 1 roof is being worked on now.
- b. During the week, they are on the roof working on the outside/top.
- c. Over the weekend, they work inside the building Midnight-6AM and then the cleaning crew comes and cleans. This week the A/C turned on early and ended up blowing dust everywhere and then the cleaning crew came back to clean.
- d. The second grade hallway should be completed this week and then third grade finished.
- e. Building 4 A/C work should take place over Spring Break.

5. Summer Camp:

a. Summer Camp has just been approved for SLE again this summer.



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- b. Camp will run 7:00-6:00 from M-F
- c. Field Trips 10:00 -3:00 or 12:00-3:00. There will be at least 1 a week, with an in-house field trip or presenation another day.
