

Flanagan High School Course Selection for 23-24



- 1. All students will receive a grade level specific Course Selection Card. Students will only receive **one** card, do not lose it!
- 2. Check Virtual Counselor! Use your student number as the User ID and the password is a "P" followed by your birthday in the following format – DD/MM/YYYY

- Review your CURRENT schedule to view current course titles.
- Check your graduation requirements to ensure you are selecting all courses required for your graduation.
- Check your test scores & GPA.
- 3. You will need to choose 8 courses: English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Study Hall, and 3 electives. You will also list 3 alternate elective courses that are DIFFERENT from the courses that you circle.
- 4. Speak with your current teachers and have them sign off on the class level they recommend for you based on your current performance.
- 5. Speak with your parents and ensure they are in support of your choices and that the courses you select will set you up for success next year. Have your parent sign under parent signature.
- 6. Turn your completed course selection card into your Study Hall teacher.
- 7. In February, you will meet one on one with a School Counselor to ensure proper placement for the upcoming year. We look forward to meeting you!
