This week I looked at who had the most students logging into I-Ready! Next week I will look at usage and proficiency!

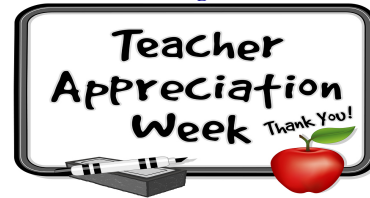
