Happy May Wildcats!

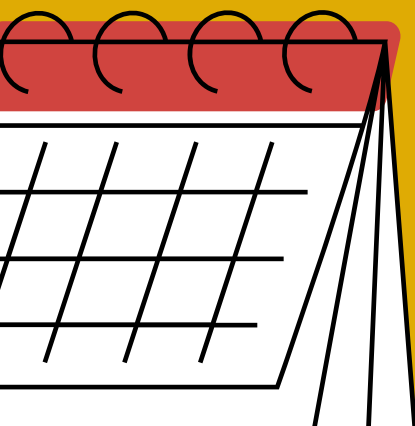

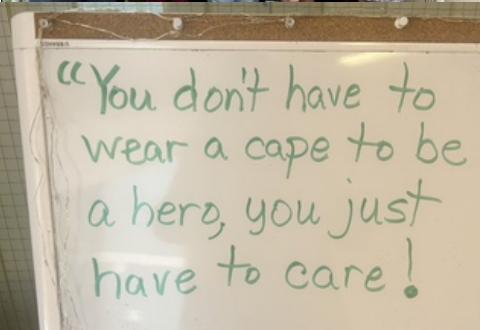

Test Taking Tips

- Be sure to get good rest the night before testing.
- Eat a good breakfast each day.
- Practice deep breathing to limit test anxiety.
- Take the stretch or standing break when you get it.
- Listen closely to all directions.
- Read the questions carefully. Know your power words: analyze, describe, illustrate, demonstrate, determine, etc.)
- Use process of elimination to narrow down your answer choices.
- Review your test before submitting.
