Back-to-School Forms

The district is continuing with the green initiative this year and all back-to-school forms are electronic. Once you complete your child/ren forms online, you will be asked to print and sign a confirmation page. It is imperative that you send that confirmation page with your child/ren. Once we get that confirmation page, we will be able to access the information electronically. Parents/guardians will have access to the online back-to-school forms at www.browardschools.com/bts . Please make it a priority to log in and complete the forms as soon as possible. It is imperative that we have current and accurate contact information for all students in order to communicate with parents/guardians in the event of an emergency.

Gate Information

West Walker Gate (Lincoln Street) will be open from 8:40am - 9:10am and 3:40pm - 4:00pm.

Front Gate (Lincoln Street) will be open all day. Parents will be issued two new Beachside tags which will be necessary to enter the front gate. Anyone without a tag will be stopped by security and asked to provide identification and nature of visit.

Back Gate (Pierce street) will open at 3:15pm for bus arrival and PK student pick-up. Green carpool users will be permitted to enter the back gate after 3:30pm.

Green Carpool:

Families interested in Green Carpool pick-up for the 2019-20 school year will need to complete a new application. Single or multiple families that will pick up 4 or more children on a daily basis are encouraged to apply. Applications are available in the front office and on our school website.

Volunteer Application

If you are interested in volunteering at Beachside or any other public school in Broward County, you will need to fill out the volunteer application online at www.browardschools.com. You will need to click on the Parents & Families tab in the upper left-hand side of the homepage and then click the Get Involved link on the left side of the page. Your application cannot be processed unless all the requested information is provided and you authorize Broward County Public Schools to conduct a criminal background check.
