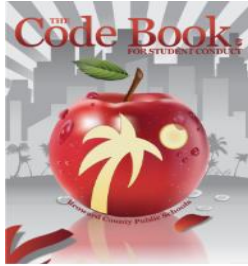

Districtwide Safety & Security Updates

Broward County Public Schools has implemented districtwide safety and security measures that must be followed by all schools. These district mandated security enhancements will be strictly reinforced throughout the school year.



All students and staff are required to wear identification badges while on campus at all times. All students will be provided an ID during the first two weeks of school. Lost student identification badges must be re-purchased for \$5.00. Students that fail to comply with the identification badge policy will be issued disciplinary consequences.

All visitors must enter and exit the campus through the STAR system at the Single Point entrance and be provided a school or district form of identification while on campus.

The district has also implemented specific safety and security protocol for schools that have adopted a unified dress program. New Renaissance Middle School is a unified dress code school. Students are expected to follow the dress code policy. Failure to comply with the unified dress code policy will result in disciplinary consequences.

As part of the district initiative to enhance safety and security, all schools must strictly adhere to the policy and procedures for accessing the campus by students, staff and parents/guardians. Student supervision is provided from 9:00 AM to 4:30 PM. Students cannot arrive on campus before 9:00 AM and students must be picked up by 4:30 PM. Parents choosing to drive their child to school must use the car loop for student drop off and pick up at the appropriate times. Please do not drop off student at Ansin Park or on Miramar Boulevard.

What happens if students lose their ID?

Lost ID bages must be replaced as soon as possible. Replacement ID badges are \$5.00. Failure to comply with the ID policy will result in disciplinary consequences.

Student Schedules

Students will have four classes on alternating burgundy and gold days for a total of eight classes. Student schedules will be available for pick up on Friday, August 10, 2018. Sixth grade students will receive their schedules during the orientation, from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM. The 7th and 8th grader schedules will be available for pick up from 2 PM to 4 PM in the cafeteria. Schedules can also be printed from Virtual Counselor.
