I. Welcome/Call to order

II. Reading of the minutes from our last meeting- Ms. Williams

III. Principal’s Welcome/Update -Mrs. Giancarli

- District accreditation 11/29- 12/3
 - I. 48 schools have been selected and notified as such.
- COVID19
 - I. District continues with quarantine protocols
 - II. All schools except 9 have at least 1 nurse. NRMS has 2.
 - III. Facial coverings are still required for elementary and middle school students and staff
 - IV. Changes may be made based on availability of the vaccine for children ages 5-11.
 - V. Field Trips and Athletics
 - I. Trips to Broward County Performing Arts Center are beginning in November along with virtual trips
 - II. For athletic events, students can purchase tickets online. Athletic directors for each school must bring their own ADA machine. Students are also optional to be tested for COVID19 before an athletic event.
 - III. Wandering beginning at all high school events along with new rules regarding bags at sporting events.
 - VI. FAST- New assessment based on benchmarks for student thinking
 - I. This assessment will begin next year.
 - VII. Starting this year, all 9th grade students must take and pass a financial literacy course in order to graduate.
 - VIII. Interim reports and parent contact- teachers must notify parents when their grades drop 2 grade levels from the interim to the report card.
 - IX. Policy 63.06- Teachers cannot assign homework after students have left the class period and have it due for the next class period. Students must be given notice when the assignment is posted/assigned.
 - X. Pandemic School Levels:
 - I. 6 middle schools dropped to an F.
 - II. 16 dropped to a D.
 - III. We dropped from a C to a D.
 - XI. As a VILS school, students have access to technology. Many students have still not signed out their iPads. PCG tutoring is providing 1 to 3 tutoring for our lowest quartile students.
 - XII. ELOs (extended learning opportunities) will begin on November 29th. Saturday tutoring will begin in January right after winter break.



- XIII. Cavalier Connection Time- 34 minute homeroom period to address SEL
- XIV. We are receiving additional laptops.
- XV. Harvest Drive is being extended until November 12th.
 - I. Each family receives about 3 weeks of groceries
- XVI. Our Students Working Against Tobacco was recognized as the Broward County Schools Club of the Year
