  - 6306 homework policy. Teachers should not assign homework after the bell has rung.
    Letter J states that if a homework is posted after class, the student needs 2 class
    meetings to turn in their work. If the teachers continues to go against the policy,
    students should tell their parents, the parent should contact the assistant principal, and
    then go up the chain of command.
  - Distant learning initiative. Not all high schools offer the same classes, however the high schools should promote these classes.
  - There are limitations on students who do dual enrollment. The district is trying to convey a committee to handle dual enrollment. There's a new amendment going to the board for summer dual enrollment at Broward College.
  - SAC funds can only be spent on SIP.
  - Raptor program. The district is reviewing the components that were purchased with raptor. Questions for our schools are is the front office trained to use raptor? When issues with the raptor system occurs is the 1800 number called?
  - 4 day school week. Pompano Beach high school has their budget posted on their website likewise the office of service quality.
  - Positivity being done at our schools should be shared instead of all the negativity going around.
