On Saturday, January 18, 2020, Awesome Olsen iCAN Robotics and Marine Science Magnet students competed in the Science Olympiad Regional Competition at the University of Miami in Miami, Florida. Science Olympiad competition is the ultimate demonstration that enables schools to challenge students and apply their learning through creating projects and immersing themselves in science as it applies to various disciplines. Students work individually and cooperatively to create, think critically, build and rebuild, problem solve, discover, and have loads of fun. This prestigious competition empowers students to compete against public, private, and charter school teams locally and statewide if successful.

Awesome Olsen iCAN Magnet Academy students prepare diligently for Science Olympiad competitions by extending their school day by an hour each day/5 additional hours each week and attend Saturday practices to prepare for this prestigious and rigorous level of science competition.

Congratulations to the Awesome Olsen Middle iCAN Magnet Academy students. Their hard work paid off, for, at the University of Miami Regional Science Olympiad Competition, they placed first, second, or third place in the nearly all categories, including placing first place in the boom lever category and the mouse car racer category (their car when further than any other car this year in both middle school and high school levels).

The team placed third place overall and has once again earned an invitation to Science Olympiad State Competition, which will be held at the University of Florida in Gainesville, to compete against Science Olympiad Teams representative from the entire state of Florida.
