<p>Violation #54. Garbage &amp; refuse disposal Dumpster/recyclable area littered/accumulation of garbage exists. Clean dumpster area, maintain in sanitary manner. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Garbage shall be disposed of to prevent vector harborage. Trash cans will be durable, cleanable, leak proof, insect and rodent resistant, and non-absorbent. Outside storage area shall be of a smooth, non-absorbent material and sloped to a drain.</p>
<p>Violation #55. Facilities installed, maintained, &amp; clean Ceiling tiles bulging in dry storage and near exit door. Repair/replace ceiling tiles.</p> <p>Electrical outlets, hanging from ceiling in prep area dirty, in disrepair. Repair/clean electrical outlets.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, durable, easily cleanable, and non-absorbent. Exterior areas shall be kept cleaned.</p>
