Students/Adults will not be able to pay with cash for the tickets at the entrance. If fans or parents want to attend the games, please download the GoFan App. Physical tickets will no longer be able to be sold.

Lastly, we want to keep you informed of the COVID cases reported for students and staff on campus. We had 5 cases reported this week. All close contacts have been advised and as always, all areas of the school continue to be disinfected and cleaned for students and staff safety.
